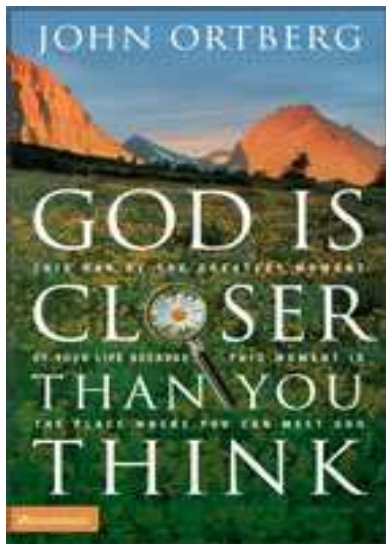
The 'See You at the Pole' event will be held at CAIS on October 3 from 7:15-7:45 a.m. in the school courtyard. All those who wish to participate can

### Secondary Spiritual Emphasis Week (SEW)

The secondary SEW will be held at CAIS from October 9 through 13 with special events scheduled for October 9, 11 and 13. The objective of the program is to enable students to come to a personal relationship with God and to make a deeper commitment to Him. The theme for the week is "God is closer than you think" and it explores the reality of God's presence in the world and how much He desires to have connection and communion with people in their daily schedule of life. The program consists of times of worship, DVD talks by John Ortberg, and small group discussions.
